

Roman Pottery of the Kırşehir Kale Höyük

The archaeological excavations were carried out in the Kırşehir Kale Höyük during 2009 and also between 2012-2013. Due to heavy destructions, good preserved Roman layers could not be determined at the site, but characteristic Roman and Late Roman pots were detected in the rubbish pits and the mixed fillings. Among these vessels, samples of the terra sigillata and Late Roman red slip wares the most important evidence for create chronology of the Roman period at the settlement.
