

Dye Plants of Eskişehir

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Eskişehir has a rich culture and was used extensively in the past plant dyes. Last time in the use of dye plants were gradually being forgotten. Plant pigments, plant roots, stems, leaves and flowers are derived from such organs. Herbal colors color spectrometers are equipped with a wide range of paints. If handled properly, will remain intact for a long time.

In the Eskişehir region where natural dyes are used, 54 plant species were identified as sources of natural dyes. These selected plants; black, brown, red and yellow pigments, mainly serves their various intermediate colors. Dye plants grown in the region are the most important; daisy (yellow color), indigo (blue color), iris (green color) and madder (red color).

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
